


Parking on the zig zags, across driveways and in the 'school keep clear zone' causes great frustration to all of us. At Cramond we also have the danger of cars driving up the cul-de-sacs and then reversing in a small space to turn round. This causes a **major road safety hazard**. Cramond School, The Junior Road Safety Officers and Cramond Parents are planning a PARKSMART campaign to help make coming to school safer for all. Our aims are:

- to discourage drivers from entering the 3 cul-de-sacs that lead to the school (see map of No Go Zones).
- to discourage drivers from parking where pedestrian access and road visibility is obscured or where traffic congestion causes a safety hazard (see map of No Park Zones).
- to highlight the dangers of reversing in the cul-de-sacs which lead to Cramond primary school
- to encourage drivers to think of residents and the children's safety, to park responsibly and walk the last bit.
- to get more people to walk or cycle to school with their child.

This means ALL parents/carers/grandparents bringing children to and from the school (including nursery) at ALL times.
