You can amend what observations or stories using this drop-down menu. They are organised by Curriculum level

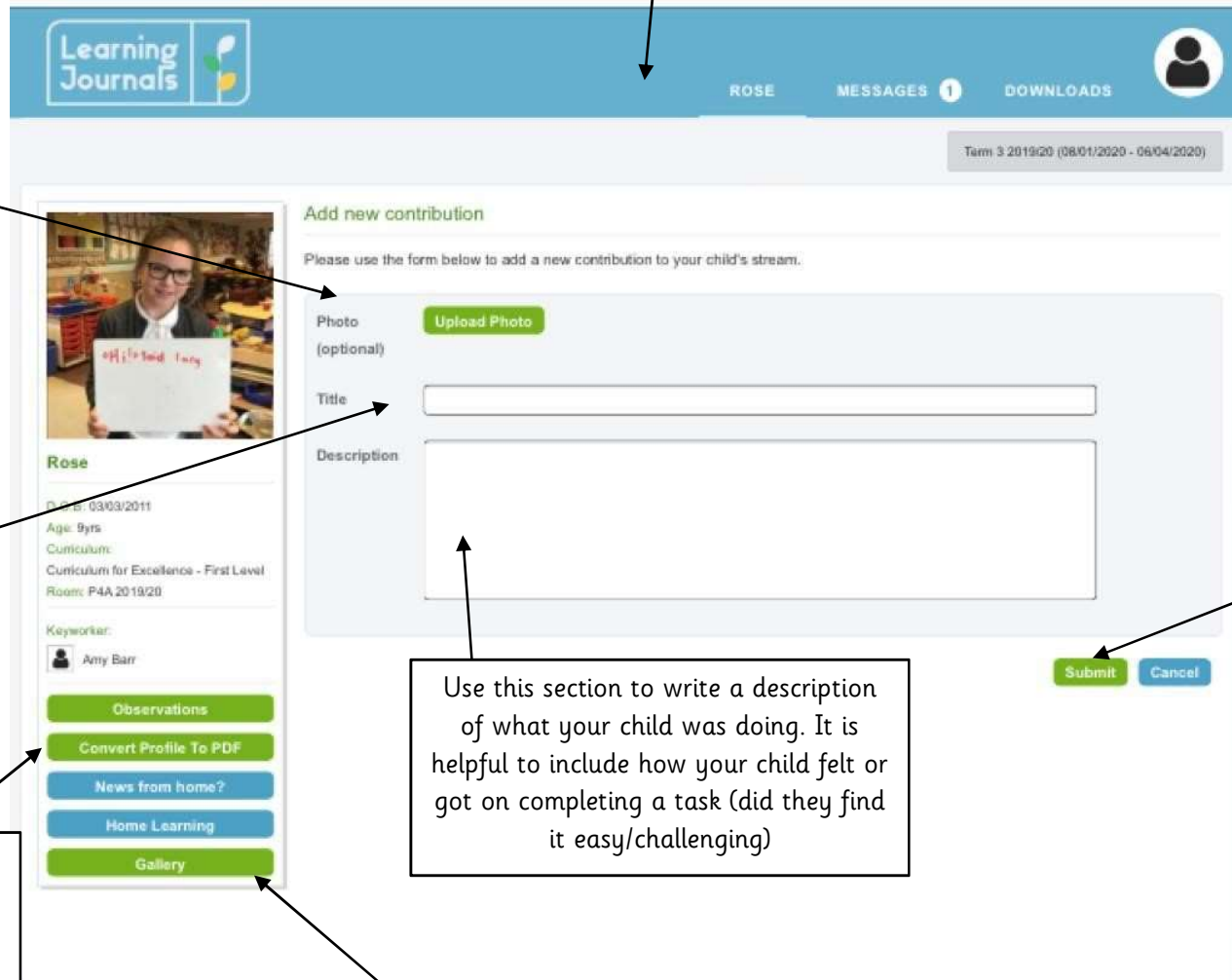
Message section: You can find messages from teachers in this section.

News from Home section: You can share any news or achievements using this tab.

Home learning section: Click on this tab to share learning from home. This will be explained on the next page.

Please share your thoughts using the 'Like' button or write a message using the 'Comments' button. This helps us to know you have read observations/ stories and provides feedback to both your child and the teacher.
