

The Crucial Role of the Adult

Teachers and support staff

- Observe, interact and extend children's thinking.
- Model skills and encourage reflection.
- Ensure balance between play, inquiry and structured learning.
- Are guided by research.





Supporting Your Child's Transition

- Partnership with nurseries and ELC settings.
- Transition activities (visits, stay and play)
- Focus on wellbeing and confidence.
- Practise independence, selfcare, listening and turntaking at home.



Considering Deferral of Entry?

Children born 10 Aug 2021 – 28 Feb 2022 may defer to Aug 2027

All eligible children have right to further funded ELC

Application window: 1 Nov 2025 – 28 Feb 2026
